




7 Mistakes How to Book Sandals Resorts for HALF the Price (Insider Guide)

- Referral credits
- Email-exclusive deals

Example:

A traveler combined a sale + loyalty discount + credit card points → saved nearly **45% total**

Mistake #4: Choosing the Wrong Room Category

Not all “upgrades” are worth it.
